#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

All electrical connections must be made in accordance with all ordinances, and Local and National Electrical Codes.

### **STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS**

Before starting your installation, disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breaker or by removing the fuse at the fuse box. Just turning the light off at the light switch is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock.

#### PREPARE FIXTURE

Remove post screws from fixture by unscrewing the screws from the base using the Allen Key.

# **MAKE WIRE CONNECTIONS**

Connect the BLACK fixture wire to the BLACK supply wire and the WHITE fixture wire to the WHITE supply wire.

Connect the fixture ground wire to the J-BOX ground wire or wrap around one of the protruding screws on the mounting plate. Secure all connections with the supplied wire nuts and electrical tape (not supplied).

# **INSTALL THE POLE OR BASE**

Secure the fixture to the pole or base with the supplied screws.

### **INSTALL BULB**

Install your E26 bulb (100W Max).

DO NOT EXCEED THE WATTAGE AS STATED ON THE WARNING LABEL.
