

## **IMPORTANT**


#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

All electrical connections must be made in accordance with all ordinances, and local and national electrical codes. These fixtures are intended for mounting to a standard 4" junction box. The box must be directly supported by the building structure and be ETL or U.L. Recognized.

## STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Before starting your installation disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breaker or by removing the fuse at the fuse box. Just turning the light off at the light switch is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock.

#### WHAT WE PROVIDE




#### **UNPACK YOUR FIXTURE**

Carefully set aside all parts and pieces.



# **ATTACH ARMS**

Attach each arm to the round center component of the fixture body by threading them in place clockwise.

## **DETERMINE HEIGHT**

Measure fixture to desired height. Please note this must be done in 6" increments. Once determined, thread desired number of rods down onto the cone on top of the round fixture body, while feeding the wire up and through each rod, one at a time. Trim wire to leave an additional 12-18" of access wire for adjusting.

# PREPARE CANOPY

Carefully slide knurled ring then canopy down the rods and allow to rest on top the fixture body cone.



# ATTACH FIXTURE TO MOUNTING BAR

Feed the wires through the swivel attachment and mounting bar.

Attach swivel to the rods, threading down clockwise.



# **PREPARE WIRES**


Pull all supply wires out of the junction box. You will need to access these wires after installation.

NOTE: Keep wires to the side of the mounting bar when installing fixture.



## **INSTALL FIXTURE**

Holding fixture wires down below the mounting bar, lift assembled fixture up to the junction box. Secure to the ceiling by attaching the mounting bar to the junction box with the Phillips head screws provided.



## **MAKE WIRE CONNECTIONS**

Connect BLACK supply wire to BLACK fixture wire, WHITE supply wire to WHITE fixture wire, and raw copper SUPPLY ground wire to raw copper or green FIXTURE ground wire, using the approved wire nuts, included.



# **SECURE CANOPY**

Place all wire connectors and excess wire into the junction box.

Lift canopy and knurled ring up to the ceiling and thread ring to secure in place. Some adjustments may be needed to assure enough threaded rod is exposed to allow for the canopy to fit tightly to the ceiling. Once the angle of the swivel and fixture is in the position you would like, use the set screw to lock the position. Hand tighen to secure.

## **INSTALL THE BUBLS AND GLASS**

Insert LED bulbs into the sockets and install glass shades onto the socket by rotating clockwise.

MAXIMUM WATTAGE 40W MAX PER SOCKET.
