

## WARNING/CAUTION

- DISCONNECT POWER BEFORE RE-LAMPING OR WIRING THE FIXTURE. READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS COMPLETELY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION.
- TO AVOID THE RISK OF FIRE OR SHOCK, FIXTURE MUST BE INSTALLED IN COMPLIANCE WITH ALL APPLICABLE NATIONAL AND LOCAL ELECTRICAL/BUILDING CODES. THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THIS UNIT SHOULD BE COMPLETED BY A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN OR CERTIFIED FACTORY TRAINED TECHNICIAN.

## FIXTURE INSTALLATION

1. Loosen the END SCREWS (6) to remove the COVER (7) from the FIXTURE ASSEMBLY (4) .
2. Attach the Ground wire (Green) to the ground inside the outlet box (Generally green or bar copper wire) or the ground screw on the crossbar. NEVER CONNECT GROUND WIRE TO "HOT" WIRE! FAILURE TO FOLLOW THIS COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH!
3. Connect the white fixture lead to the neutral (Generally white) wire in the outlet box. Fasten the wires together with an approved fastener (WIRE NUTS) (2). Starting 1" below the fastener, tightly wrap the connection with electrical tape so that the connections seals the end of the fastener. MAKE SURE THERE ARE NO EXPOSED WIRE OF STRANDS THAT COULD CAUSE A DANGEROUS SHORT CIRCUIT!
4. Connect the black fixture leads to the hot (Generally black) wire in the junction box. Fasten the joined wires same as previous step. NEVER REVERSE HOT AND NEUTRAL WIRES. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THIS COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH!
5. Attach the FIXTURE ASSEMBLY (4) onto the POST (1) and fasten it in place with the SET SCREWS (3).
6. Screw the BULBS (5)(not included) up into the SOCKET of the fixture. THIS FIXTURE IS RATED FOR 60 WATT LAMP. DO NOT EXCEED THE RECOMMENDED WATTAGE!
7. Attach the COVER (7) onto the FIXTURE ASSEMBLY (4) and secure with the END SCREWS (6).
8. Restore power to the outlet at the breaker or fuse box.
